

## GCAA SCHOLARSHIP

Overview, Inc. joins with the Georgia Community Action Association in announcing the availability of a two thousand five hundred dollar (\$2500) scholarship to be awarded on a statewide basis to a Georgia resident who is currently attending a post high school institution or has been accepted at an educational institution. The individual must be income eligible in accordance with the Community Services Block Grant guidelines and be successfully judged a winner in an essay writing competition. The essay is to be entitled "What Has the Community Action Movement Meant to My Community". The Georgia Community Action Association is a professional association composed of twenty member agencies from across the Georgia, one of which is Overview, Inc.

### GCAA SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES:

1. Must meet CSBG Income Guidelines.
2. Must be currently attending an institution of higher learning (college/university/voc-tech school) or must have already been accepted by one of the same.
3. Must prepare an essay to be entitled, "What Has the Community Action Movement Meant to My Community". The essay **must not** contain the name of the nominee.

- A. History (0-25 points)
- B. Impact of Movement on Me and MY Community (0-50 points)
- C. How I View Community Action in the 21<sup>st</sup> Century (0-25 points)
